



ICC T20 World Cup Australia 2020 (T20WC)

Child & Infant Ticket Policy

Effective 30 January 2019

The following policies apply in respect of tickets purchased to:

ICC T20 World Cup 2020 (T20WC) matches scheduled to be played in Australia during the year 2020 including without limitation:

- a) Women's Tournament matches;
- b) Men's Tournament matches; and
- c) Preparation Hub - Warm Up matches.

CHILD & INFANT POLICY

Children aged 2-16 years as at the day of the match are eligible for purchase of a child ticket (subject to availability).

Infants under two years of age at the day of the scheduled match are entitled to enter a venue without a ticket and at no charge, however, they must not occupy a seat of their own and must sit in an adult lap. There may only be one (1) infant per adult lap in a seat, and each adult does require their own valid ticket for entry.

The Ticket Holder purchasing the ticket and bringing the child to a match is required to:

- a) Provide photo identification for proof of age if requested by any Authorised Person in any of the following situations:
 - a. At the time of purchase;
 - b. Upon entry to the ground;
 - c. At any time while attending the designated match;
- b) Children aged sixteen (**16**) years and under must be accompanied by a full paying adult.

Each child is to be counted as one (1) ticket towards the ticket holder ticket limit for each match as set out in the Ticket Limit Policy.

DEFINITIONS

KEY TERM	DEFINITION
Match	Refers to a T20WC cricket match (or matches, where two such matches are played in the same Venue on the same day) forming part of the Tournament or any other cricket match played as part of the official warm-up phase of the Tournament, the particulars of which are indicated on the Ticket;
Ticket Holder	Refers to any individual purchasing, possessing, holding or using a Ticket, including (without limitation) the Ticket Purchaser, Ticket Account Holder or any person to whom a Ticket has been issued or transferred.
Child	Refers to ticket holders aged 2-16 years as at the day of the match
Infant	Refers to individuals under two years of age at the day of the match who do not require a ticket for entry into a venue but cannot occupy their own seat
LOC	Refers to the T20 World Cup 2020 Ltd (a company incorporated in Australia (ABN:14 618 113 269) which has been appointed as the local Organising Committee for the Tournament by Cricket Australia.
Tournament	Means the ICC T20 World Cup Australia 2020 (Men's and Women's).
