



ICC T20 World Cup Australia 2020 (T20WC)

Restricted View Ticket Policy

Effective 30 January 2019

The following policy applies in respect of tickets purchased to:

ICC T20 World Cup Australia 2020 (T20WC) matches scheduled to be played in Australia during the year 2020 including without limitation:

- a. Women's 2020 Tournament Matches
- b. Men's 2020 Tournament Matches and
- c. Preparation Hub - Warm Up Matches

RESTRICTED VIEW POLICY

A seat will be defined as restricted view if a minimum of 20% of the ticket holder's view of the field of play is impaired due to the location of the seats, or where an object is positioned in the line of sight of the ground (based on the height of an average adult) – for example, a handrail, speaker, camera, or venue infrastructure etc.

Whether a seat is restricted view will be determined by the T20WC LOC in its sole discretion. All restricted view seats that are made available for purchase will be flagged in the ticketing system as "restricted view" at the time of purchase.

Tickets purchased with the restricted view flag will not be entitled to a relocation or refund at tournament time due to their impaired view.

Each restricted view ticket is to be counted as one (1) ticket towards the ticket holder's ticket limit for each match as set out in the Ticket Limit Policy.

DEFINITIONS

| KEY TERM | DEFINITION |
|-------------------------|---|
| Match | Refers to a T20WC cricket match (or matches, where two such matches are played in the same Venue on the same day) forming part of the Tournament or any other cricket match played as part of the official warm-up phase of the Tournament, the particulars of which are indicated on the Ticket; |
| LOC | Refers to the T20 World Cup 2020 Ltd (a company incorporated in Australia (ABN:14 618 113 269) which has been appointed as the Local Organising Committee for the Tournament by Cricket Australia. |
| Restricted View Tickets | Refer to those tickets purchased which offer a partially obstructed view of the field of play. In many cases, these obstructed views refer to a limited view of the boundary lines or certain areas of the pitch. |
| Ticket Holder | Refers to any individual purchasing, possessing, holding or using a Ticket, including (without limitation) the Ticket Purchaser, Ticket Account Holder or any person to whom a Ticket has been issued or transferred. |
| Tournament | Means the ICC T20 World Cup Australia 2020 (Men's and Women's). |
