



ICC T20 World Cup Australia 2020 (T20WC)

Ticket Limit Policy

Effective 30 January 2019

This Ticket Limit Policy applies to all ICC T20 World Cup 2020 Matches through both Women's and Men's Tournaments.

When purchasing tickets for the ICC T20 World Cup 2020 (T20WC) you, as a Ticket Holder, will be limited to the specified number of tickets listed below.

WOMEN'S TOURNAMENT (allocation per Match up to a maximum of 6 Matches in total)

MATCH	TICKET LIMIT
Warm Up Match*	Six (6) maximum
Group Match	Ten (10) maximum
Semi-Final	Eight (8) maximum
Final	Eight (8) maximum

MEN'S TOURNAMENT (allocation per Match up to a maximum of 10 Matches in total)

MATCH	TICKET LIMIT
First Round/Super 12	Ten (10) maximum
Semi-Final	Eight (8) maximum
Final	Eight (8) maximum

The maximum number of Matches in which tickets can be purchased is six (**6**) for Women's and ten (**10**) for Men's Tournaments.

**Warm up matches do not count towards the number of matches a customer can purchase.*

If you exceed the stated ticket limit, you may have any or all of your orders and tickets associated with T20WC cancelled without notice by the LOC or IBC at its discretion. This includes orders associated with the same name, e-mail address, billing address, credit card number or other information. Ticket limits apply to ensure fair access to tickets for fans, and as a measure to minimise ticket scalping.

DEFINITIONS

KEY TERM	DEFINITION
Match	Refers to a T20WC match (or matches, where two such matches are played in the same Venue on the same day) forming part of the Tournament or any other cricket match played as part of the official warm-up phase of the Tournament, the particulars of which are indicated on the Ticket;
Ticket Holder	Refers to any individual purchasing, possessing, holding or using a Ticket, including (without limitation) the Ticket Purchaser, Ticket Account Holder or any person to whom a Ticket has been issued or transferred.
IBC	Refers to the ICC Business Corporation FZ LLC, a wholly owned subsidiary of the ICC incorporated to exploit the commercial rights to ICC events, being a company incorporated under the regulations of the Dubai Creative Clusters Authority with its registered address at Office No. 28, Second Floor, Building 2, Dubai Media City, United Arab Emirates, and having its administrative office at Street 69, Dubai Sports City, Sheikh Mohammed Bin Zayed Road, PO Box 500070, Dubai, United Arab Emirates.
LOC	Refers to the T20 World Cup 2020 Ltd (a company incorporated in Australia (ABN:14 618 113 269) which has been appointed as the Local Organising Committee for the Tournament by Cricket Australia.
Tournament	Means the ICC T20 World Cup Australia 2020 (Men's and Women's).
